A-F Letter Grades: Proficiency Levels for Students



Highly Proficient (Level 4)

✓ <u>Advanced</u> understanding, <u>highly</u> likely to be ready (for the next grade level).

Proficient (Level 3)

✓ <u>Strong</u> understanding, likely to be ready (for the next grade level).

Partially Proficient (Level 2)

✓ <u>Partial</u> understanding, likely to <u>need support</u> be ready (for the next grade level).

Minimally Proficient (Level 1)


Minimal understanding, highly likely to <u>need support</u> be ready (for the next grade level).



A-F Letter Grades: K-8 Structure




- ✓ Percentage of proficient students on the AASA grade level assessment (grades 3-8)
- Longitudinal indicators of relative student growth
- ✓ English Learner language proficiency and growth (grades K-8)



Areas/Strengths Contributing to Strong A-F Performances



Painted Sky - Large gains in 3rd grade Math (+21) and ELA (+30) & 5th grade Math (+12) and ELA (+12)

Multiple Schools saw increased performance and growth on the AZELLA English Language proficiency test

Holaway - Significant improvement in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade Mathematics

Coronado - strong performances in 3rd, 5th, 8th grade ELA and 6th, 8th grade Math

IRHS - Increases in graduation rates, College and Career Readiness, and Bonus Points for ACT Aspire.





Rio Vista – Decreases in student growth points, as well as 4th grade ELA and Math proficiency points. EL Proficiency/Growth; Grade 5 ELA and Math gains.







Donaldson – Performance and Growth in ELA and Math AASA; Grade 3 ELA/Math Proficiency/Growth for English Learning students Proficiency/Growth of population subgroups.

Nash – Performance and Growth in ELA and Math AASA Proficiency/Growth for English Learning students Proficiency/Growth of population subgroups; Students w/Disabilities



2023-2024 Percent Passing- English Language Arts










English Language Arts Proficiency – Grade Level








State Assessment Mathematics Proficiency – Grade Level


