This location should be used for the solar panels because it provides a clear view of them for passing students and staff. The school also faces south, so putting the solar panels in this location would obviously be filling that requirement. Additionally, where the solar panels are placed, there is less shade. In front of the school, there are no trees close enough to cast a shadow and by being on the roof, they are not covered by a shadow from the second level. Although the

drawing is not exactly to scale, the solar panels will fit the length of this space. If they possibly don't, we can put a metal bar in the back and stack one on top of the other. In conclusion, the solar panels should be installed on the roof of the front entrance to Lincoln Hall.
