## ACTION APPROVING AGREEMENT WITH LINEBARGER GOGGAN BLAIR & SAMPSON, LLP

After having provided adequate notice as required by Section 2254.1036 of the Texas Government Code, the Agreement for Tax Collection Services with Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP is approved and the President of the Lamar Consolidated Independent School District (School District) Board of Trustees is authorized to execute this Agreement.

After exercising its due diligence the School District finds that:

- 1. There is a substantial need for the legal services to be provided pursuant to the Agreement for Tax Collection Services;

- 5. Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP has provided these specialized legal services to the School District in the past and the School District has been well satisfied with the quality and outcome of the legal services provided.
