<b>Agenda Item:</b> Consider Approval of the Distributed Antenna System (DAS) RFP 2425-004
<p><b>Summary:</b></p> <p>A solicitation for proposals was issued and ten (10) responses were received. After the evaluation of the submitted proposals, it is recommended to award this project to the vendor that provides the best value to the District: Aerowave Technologies, Inc with a proposal cost of \$639,039.15 and not to exceed the amount of \$650,000.</p> <p>The proposal includes installation of equipment that will increase the emergency responder radio coverage using a bi-directional amplifier/distributed antenna system at THS East and West, Gilbert Willie and Wood Elementary. In addition, the district will exercise an option to implement a cellular bi-directional amplifier to enhance the cellular signal at the same locations.</p> <p>This RFP adhered to all requirements for expenditures under Federal Education Department General Administrative Regulations (EDGAR).</p> <p>The Safety and Security team will work closely with Facility Services to oversee the scheduling of the installation of this project to provide the least amount of interference with campus activities.</p>
