- **Topic:** How does Your Garden Grow; Growth in our Village”
- **Date:** Postponed to November 2017 (Date TBD: based on availability of Moderator)
- **Required Action (s):** Add the IGOV Assembly to an October Board meeting and prepare a list of “Issues” (beyond cost) that your Board/Taxing body will need to address if Oak Park’s population were to increase by approximately 5000 residents. *Note Issues/impacts should include both pros and cons, services that will need to be expanded, added, and eliminated.*
- Proposed assembly to be a "dispassionate”, neutral, and data driven discussion of what additional demands are placed upon our Village by increased density in order to have an educated discussion about how to plan in order to maintain current level/quality of services
- Assembly to be moderated by neutral party (neither “pro nor con increased-development”)
- Each board to determine what additional stresses will be placed upon them to provide current level of service to increased population (approximately 5000 residents as a starting point for conversation- this is an arbitrary number chosen so that all taxing bodies have the same point of reference)
- Possible additional information to be presented by Village emergency services and Township Assessor concerning census data and median home price
- Means of communication and public outreach to promote assembly--- online ad (to be paid out of IGOV budget), online survey for feedback, op-ed piece by IGOV to educate public as to what the conversation will be
