

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SCHOOL DISTRICT PRIMARY ELECTION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the School Board (the “Board”) of Independent School District No. 742 (St. Cloud Area Schools) (the “District”) wishes elections in the District to be subject to the primary election system;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the District, as follows:

1. The school board hereby determines that nominees for school board office at the 2026 general election and thereafter shall be chosen by primary election.
2. The school district primary election shall be held on the date specified by law for school district primary elections. The filing periods shall be as specified by law.
3. If in any year there are more than two candidates for a specified school board position or there are more than twice as many school board candidates as there are at-large school board positions available, the District must hold a primary election in that year.
4. The District primary elections shall be conducted pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.03, as amended, and the Minnesota election laws generally. The District clerk is authorized and directed to take such actions as necessary to be prepared to conduct primary elections.
5. This resolution is effective for all ensuing elections of school board members unless it is revoked.
