## STUDENT CONDUCT ON BUSES/VEHICLES

MESD-operated buses/vehicles carrying students will shall be considered extensions of the MESD school experience. All students using MESD transportation will shall abide by the code of conduct posted in each bus or activity vehicle. Violations of the code of conduct, as well as other conduct which is improper or which jeopardizes the safety of self or others, will shall be reported by the bus/vehicle driver to the component district Transportation Supervisor. The component district Transportation Supervisor will shall, as soon as possible, inform the appropriate MESD program supervisor of such occurrence. Violators may be denied use of transportation for a period of time as deemed proper by the component district Transportation Supervisor who will immediately notify the appropriate MESD program supervisor.

The MESD will shall comply with all state and federal laws and regulations pertaining to school bus transportation:

- 1. The building principal or designee shall ensure transportation official and drivers receive notification of students having special medical or behavioral protocols identified in student records. Students violating bus rules will be afforded the procedural safeguards of the IDEA.
- 2. When considering student disciplinary procedures that may result in removal of the student, the MESD follows all special education procedures and ensures the parent and the student are afforded the procedural safeguards of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) if:
  - a. The student is receiving IEP services;
  - **b.** For the student not yet identified as a student with a disability, the MESD had knowledge that the student had a disability and needed special education.

Students who ride buses to and from MESD-sponsored activities will be notified of the rules and regulations governing their conduct on buses as well as of the consequences for violation of those rules.

Students who violate bus rules of conduct may be denied the use of transportation.

The superintendent will shall establish other regulations as necessary for the safe conduct of students riding MESD buses or other forms of district transportation. Such regulations will shall be available to all parents and students and posted in each school bus or other MESD bus/vehicle.
