1. Cameras~We have installed 19 new cameras around the school. 2 people in the office have a monitor for camera use, Shelly White in attendance has a monitor also. 2. Water Fill Stations~ 2 Water Fill Stations have been installed. 1 near the gym and 1 in the commons area near the counseling center. Kids and staff are enjoying the fill stations.
3. Space for new programs~ We have had to change things around to accommodate our new Special Ed program. We move our IVAC from that building to the old attendance room.
