



2011-12 BOARD GOALS

1. During the 2011-12 school year, the number of students in grade 11 who meet or exceed grade level performance standards in writing will improve by 3.5% as measured by Oregon Writing Assessment.
2. During the 2011-12 school year, the number of students in grades 3-12 who improve their math and reading skills by meeting or exceeding the benchmark will improve by 3.5% annually as measured by OAKS.
3. MCSD will provide necessary programs for all students to meet the Oregon Essential skills requirement for high school graduation by collecting passing work samples for Math, Reading, and Writing in grades 3-12. MCSD will work in partnership with all stakeholders to implement our District 236 plan to provide the necessary programs, learning opportunities, and interventions to facilitate this goal, and to move toward the state's future 40-40-20 goal for education.
4. Develop and foster strong communication practices that support the district's mission and goals with all stakeholder populations as determined by annual survey. MCSD will build trust and improve partnerships with communities, including parents, business, civic and cultural groups through the use of social media. MCSD will look to develop a transparent and consistent communication system that keeps stakeholders informed and connected to important news and events in our school district.
5. Maintain a strong financial management plan that supports staying current with infrastructure and providing diverse learning opportunities for students.
