3. Review and Discuss recommendation to adopt the FY22 Tentative Budget with changes as the FY22 Final Budget

Mr. Josh Aurand reviewed changes to the FY22 Tentative Budget as attached to these Minutes (See attachment)

He noted that Salaries between regular and overtime there is a 1.23 million dollar increase due to the ESSR positions last summer school and next summer school increasing the salary benefit. These are mainly ESSR 2, and ESSR 3 has not been included. We are waiting for approval on ESSR 2.

ESSR changes are in and out daily.

O & M salaries were lowered by \$25,000 as we have higher unfilled positions as well.

Natural gas and electricity was trending slightly lower but electric went up \$41,000 and is trending higher. Now that it is cooled off it should be going down.

Josh noted that it is a combination of rate increases as well as usage for electricity costs. Kurt asked if Josh can look at that so he could tell which amounted for each of these. Josh noted that historically it swings quite a bit. He will check into it.

He reviewed the grant for the wall repair

Mike asked about estimated tax amounts from the Village. Josh noted we extended it for Lowes, Kohls and they agreed to reimburse our normal taxes less the Menards building and land near Taco Bell. When he gets the projection we lowered the tax rate and it will adjust out. It will be a temporary figure however.
