Would you like to participate in a research study that focuses on improving outcomes for American Indian and Alaska Native Students?

The extent to which students feel welcomed and supported in their classrooms impacts their overall school success. To help us better understand the extent to which teachers implement practices associated with culturally responsive classrooms, we would like to administer a survey to teachers in schools serving American Indian students. The survey queries teachers about their practices to (a) promote positive relationships with their students and families, (b) teach academic content, (c) provide social support, and (d) engage with their school's community
