RECOMMENDATION:

The Texas Education Agency allows school districts the opportunity to offer a program that will offer flexible hours and days of attendance for students who meet any of the following criteria:

- A student is at risk of dropping out of school, as defined by the TEC, §29.081;
- A student is attending a campus implementing an innovative redesign with an approved campus turnaround plan in accordance with 39.107;
- A student is attending a community-based dropout recovery education program, as defined by the TEC, §29.081(e-1) and (e-2);
- A student is attending an approved early college high school program, as defined by the TEC, §29.908;
- A student as a result of attendance requirements under the TEC, §25.092, will be denied credit for one or more classes in which the student has been enrolled.

In an effort to assist with the reduction of the dropout rate and increase student attendance rates at Lyndon B. Johnson and United South High Schools, Administration proposes to continue to implement the PASS Program at Johnson High School and add the PASS program at United South High School.
