**SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING - AEIS Report
(Academic Excellence Indicator System) Report**

BOARD GOAL ADDRESSED: All students will achieve educational excellence.

FISCAL NOTE: None

The Keller Independent School District annually presents its AEIS Report during a public hearing hosted by the School Board and the District Educational Improvement Committee (DEIC). Attached is a copy of the 2005-2006 AEIS Report from the Texas Education Agency. According to Texas Education Code 39.053, every district's Board of Trustees is required to: (a) publish an annual report describing the district's educational performance on the AEIS indicators (and include the campus performance objectives); (b) hold a hearing for public discussion of the report; (c) widely disseminate the report within the district.

Changes to this year's AEIS report:

- a. **PBM Special Education Monitoring Results Status:** Replaces the former Special Education Compliance Status last reported on the 2002-03 AEIS reports
- b. **Grade 8 Science:** (05-06 first administration) Performance on this assessment will not be incorporated into the state accountability system until 2008
- c. **Grade 11 Results:** A footnote has been added to clarify the use of the June and October results
- d. **TAKS-I Results:** (05-06 first administration) Results summed across grades are shown by subject
- e. **Participation:** Results broken down by (1) tested and (2) non-tested categories
- f. **RPTE and English Language Learners:** RPTE measures previously reported are replaced with a new English Language Learner (ELL) measure
- g. **Texas Success Initiative for ELA and Mathematics:** Replaces TAAS/TASP Equivalency

- h. **College Readiness Indicators:** Existing AEIS indicators related to college readiness have been grouped together under this new heading
- i. **Multi-year History on the TEA Website:** Multi-year history features AEIS reports from 2003 forward

A detailed power point reviewing the Keller ISD 2005-2006 AEIS data will be presented. An AEIS report for each campus is available on the Keller ISD website. In addition, a resource book with copies of AEIS reports for all Keller ISD campuses is located in each campus library.
