DESCRIPTION:

Policy 516 Student Medication - Section VI. C. indicates that "the school district may consider obtaining and possessing epinephrine auto-injectors to be maintained and administered by school personnel to a student or other individual if, in good faith, it is determined that person is experiencing anaphylaxis regardless of whether the student or other individual has a prescription for an epinephrine auto-injector." The policy goes on to say that "A comprehensive plan will be developed and submitted to the school board for approval for implementation".

The nursing staff presented a comprehensive plan for implementation at the July 31st Board meeting. A revision was made to the Parent Notification form (heart condition) that is attached. The epi-pens can be covered by LTFM funds if they are part of a district's emergency plan. Adoption of this plan would meet that requirement.
