The ARD committee must have documented that determination in the student's IEP. All requirements related to the provision of special education homebound instruction must be met except for face-to-face instruction from the homebound teacher.

Robstown ISD is requesting a waiver to provide synchronous remote instruction to a homebound student for 4 hours.

Yes, the campus has an objective in their campus plan to increase attendance rate from 91.01 to 93.0

*4. Describe the plan to be implemented, if the waiver is granted.

717 of 1000 characters allowed

Upon approval, the district will provide synchronous remote instruction to one student. The homebound student requires a nurse 24 hours a day. The student is immunocompromised and requires feeding through a G-tube. In addition, she has a tracheostomy, is ventilator dependent, and has a chronic respiratory failure. The Homebound service will be provided by a RISD Special Education teacher, the ARD committee has determined that the remote homebound instruction to be provided meets the needs of the student. All requirements related to the provision of special education homebound instruction will be met except for face-to-face instruction from the homebound teacher. Speech instruction will be provided remotely.

*5. How will granting this waiver help achieve the district's or campus' objective?

175 of 200 characters allowed

Approval will allow 5 days of student attendance per week from the student's participation in 4 hours of remote instruction instead of SAAH-specified face-to-face instruction.
