Enclosed for your information and records is the Fiscal Year 2019 Rocky Boy Schools approved student count.

Rocky Boy Schools submitted a 633 student count of which 559 students have been approved for JOM services and seventy-four (74) student denied. We could not include the denied students because we did not receive tribal enrollment certificates for them. The FY2019 JOM award for Rocky boy Schools is \$55,194.00 (\$98.74 per student) and there is a \$5,542.51 carryover from FY2018 for a total of \$60,736.51. Please revise the enclosed FY2019 tentative budget of \$51,880.83 to \$60,736.51 and submit it to this office by February 21, 2019.

The JOM payments will be on reimbursement basis. This means Rocky Boy Schools must submit expenditure reports before payment can be made.
