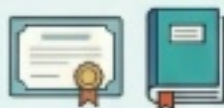

9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, grades 9-12.



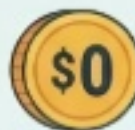
Earn While You Learn

Full Student Support

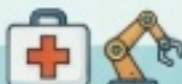
Daily free lunch and coordinated

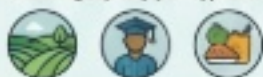

EQUITY & ACCESS: THE WEIGHTED LOTTERY



Prioritizing Underserved Students

Weighted lottery implemented due to demand
exceeding capacity (314 applicants for 133 spots).



Targeted Equity Criteria

Scoring system for first-generation, rural
schools, free/reduced lunch eligibility.



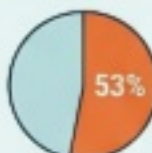
Inclusive Outreach

(IEP/304) and gender non-dominant fields.

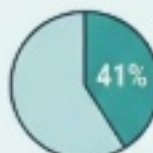
2025 IMPACT & DEMOGRAPHICS



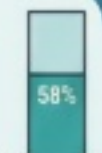
135 Students, 26 High Schools
