Overview

- High School staff and administration have been working diligently to implement the Continuity of Learning plan. The high school had a strong foundation of tools to use in this environment as a result of past work to incorporate technology and new methods of instruction utilizing flipped classroom concepts and promoting student ownership of learning.
