## **COMMENTS:**

Milk bids were received in the district offices for the milk supply for the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 years. Only one bid was received. The bid was from Cash-Wa Distributing, formerly Food Services of America. They have provided the milk supply to the district for the past few years. A recap of the bid is listed below:


RE: MILK BID

A milk bid was received from Cash-Wa Distributing, Fargo. No other communication was received from other foodservice companies regarding a milk bid. Comparing this bid to the milk bid of 2019 there is an increase in all milk pricing by .02/carton.

Extending the pricing for the milk bid received from Cash-Wa Distributing resulted in the following:

My recommendation is to accept the bid from Cash-Wa Distributing at a total of \$229,000.00

Cash-Wa Distributing would like to submit the following bid for the 2021-2022 School Year.

All homogenized milk will contain no less than 3.25% butterfat. The attached milk prices in this bid proposal are based upon April 2021 Cash-Wa Distributing's actual cost which is derived from the April 2021 raw milk prices based on an escalator clause in the 3.5% butterfat number and 1.65 zone. Cash-Wa Distributing is providing a Fixed Fee Mark-up in this proposal. Prices will fluctuate according to the raw milk market.

## Example:

February 2021 1% ½ Pints - CWD Actual Cost \$10.65 + Fixed Fee Mark-up \$1.99 = Sell Price \$12.64

April 2021 1% ½ Pints – CWD Actual Cost \$10.55 + Fixed Fee Mark-up \$1.99 = Sell Price \$12.54

Please note that the enclosed pricing is based upon the school district purchasing a minimum of 75% of its grocery purchases from Cash-Wa Distributing.

Please note all orders placed must have a 15-case minimum per drop site (minimum total could be a combination of both milk items and regular grocery items). Deliveries must be made on the same day of the school's grocery delivery day.

Milk coolers are provided through Cass Clay Creamery free of rent contingent upon awarded bid. 12 and 16 crate standard coolers are available.

Please note that Cash-Wa Distributing pricing will be derived by using the cost in which the Dairy charges us each delivery. Their cost will fluctuate according to the raw milk market. With that said CWD would not be following your request in the "Escalator" section of your RFP.

"Escalator - Milk

The Bid Month Federal Order price for Class I milk shall be the base for any increase or decrease in milk bid. If during the delivery month the Federal Order price increases or decreases 10 cents CAT from the bid month, the milk bid shall be adjusted \$0.00054 per half pint."

The Board of Education of Independent School District No. 31, Bemidji, Minnesota, will receive sealed bids for the purchase of milk for the District until 8:30 a.m., Monday, May 3rd, 2021, in the School District Administrative Office and will then be opened and read aloud.

**SPECIFICATIONS**: Copies of the specifications and bid forms are available in the office of the Director of Business Services.

Certain types of products are described in the specifications by means of reference to trade names and model numbers. Where this occurs it is understood and inferred that such description is followed by the words "or equal". Such method of description is intended as a means of establishing a standard of comparison with any other products made by any other dealer which will accomplish the purpose of the specifications.

If a company desires to furnish an item different from that specified, he shall supply data on the products he desires to furnish to enable the Board of Education to decide whether or not the item bid is in fact an equal of that specified.

A certified check or bidder's bond equal to at least 5% of the total must accompany each bid submitted.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Envelopes containing the bids must be marked, "BID – MILK SUPPLY" on the lower left hand side of the envelope and should be returned to Krisi L. Fenner, Director of Business Services, Bemidji Area Schools, 502 Minnesota Ave NW, Bemidji, MN 56601.

Bidders may withdraw their bid any time prior to the scheduled opening of the bids, but no bid shall be withdrawn for a period of thirty days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

All bids must be submitted on the appropriate bid form where requested.

An alteration or erasure may be crossed out and the correction thereof printed in ink or typewritten adjacent thereto and initialed in ink by the person signing the bid.

Delivery of milk shall be from August 1, 2021, through July 31, 2023, a **24-month period**. The successful bidder shall notify the District by May 1 each year of any increase in price for the next year; otherwise, the existing price shall continue until July the following year. The bid could be extended beyond the 24-month period if mutually agreed upon by the district and the successful bidder.
