BACKGROUND

The Official Canvass of Votes for the April 1, 2025 Consolidated Election was received on April 22, 2025 from Jean Kaczmarek, the DuPage County Clerk. The votes results for our school district are on page 155 of the [Official Canvass of Votes](#) document.

SUMMARY.

The official canvass of votes resulted in Mr. Engstrom claiming the 2-year term Board of Education member seat. The four 4-year term seats were contested with five candidates. The results for both ballot measures are below.

Grade School 25 Unexpired 2 Year School Board Member - (Vote for ONE)

VINCENT ENGSTROM received 903 votes, which equals 100.00% of the vote counted

Grade School 25 School Board Member - (Vote for FOUR)

DONALD SUTENBACH received 785 votes, which equals 24.17% of the vote counted

DENNIS H. PETERSON received 679 votes, which equals 20.91% of the vote counted

ERIC ROGERS received 635 votes, which equals 19.55% of the vote counted

ANDREW DRINNIN received 575 votes, which equals 17.70% of the vote counted

MICHAEL SZAJDA received 574 votes, which equals 17.67% of the vote counted
