    - a. Pledge of Allegiance
    - b. Public Comment
    - c. Approval of Agenda
  - 3. Consent Agenda.
    - a. Personnel
    - b. District Disbursements
    - c. Previous Minutes
  - 4. Recommended Actions.
  - 5. Reports.
  - 6. Committee Reports.
  - 7. Superintendent's Report.
  - 8. Adjournment.
- B. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
