Background and Rationale: The College solicited Sealed Proposals from vendors to supply an ambulance grade monitor / defibrillator for training our EMS students. The College only received one proposal. It was for the Zoll manufactured units. While this is an expensive option, it is the unit currently used by Fort Bend and Sugar Land EMS Departments. These multipurpose units will allow students to learn on some of the best equipment available as well as train on the exact unit that many will use on the job. Zoll is also including its “Case Review” software that provides detailed post case information regarding CPR effectiveness and information on compression depth and ECG information and blood oxygen analysis while CPR was being performed.
