- Football Field...needing repairs...walked the field with Superintendent 09-Feb-2022
- Because the field is not safe for kids, the district is looking at scraping, looking at irrigation and then re-crowning it. The problem is keeping it green due to lack of water supply. A new well and other resources have been discussed but do not appear viable at this time.
