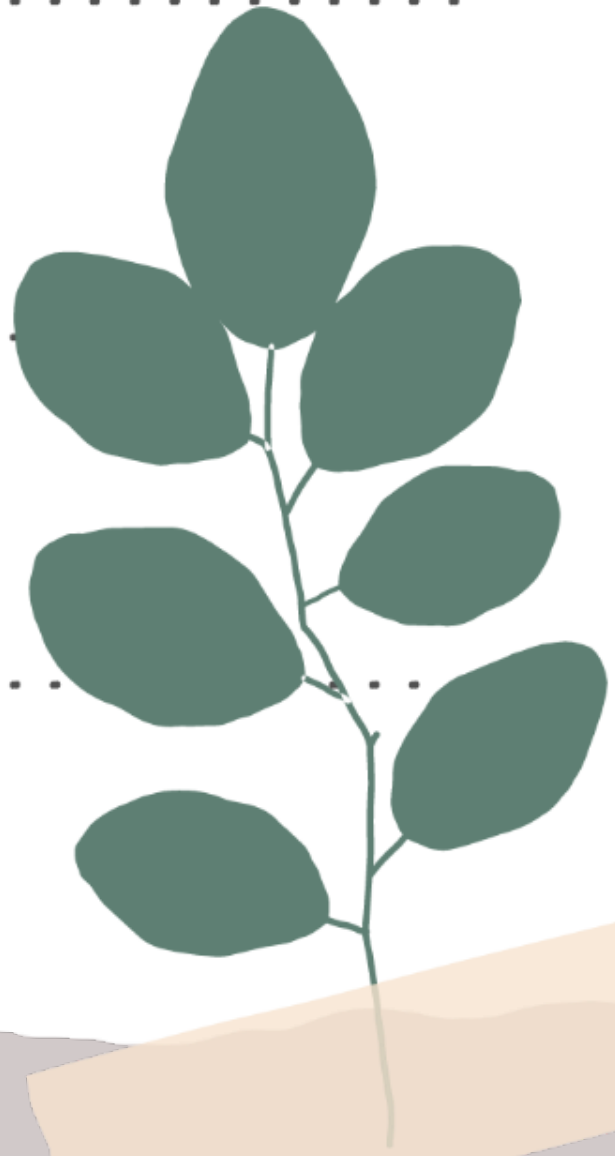

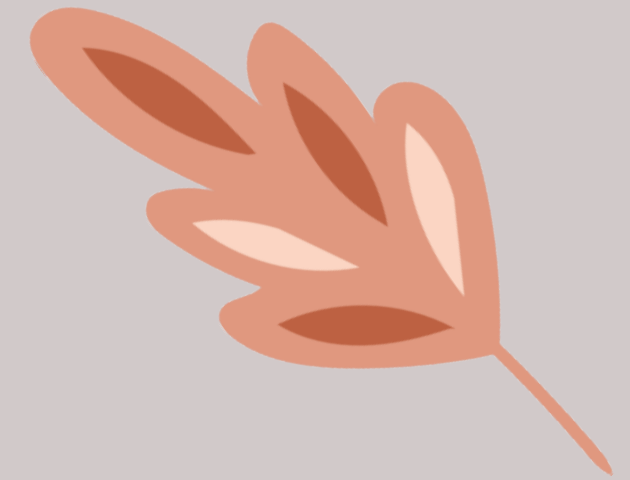


Leadership

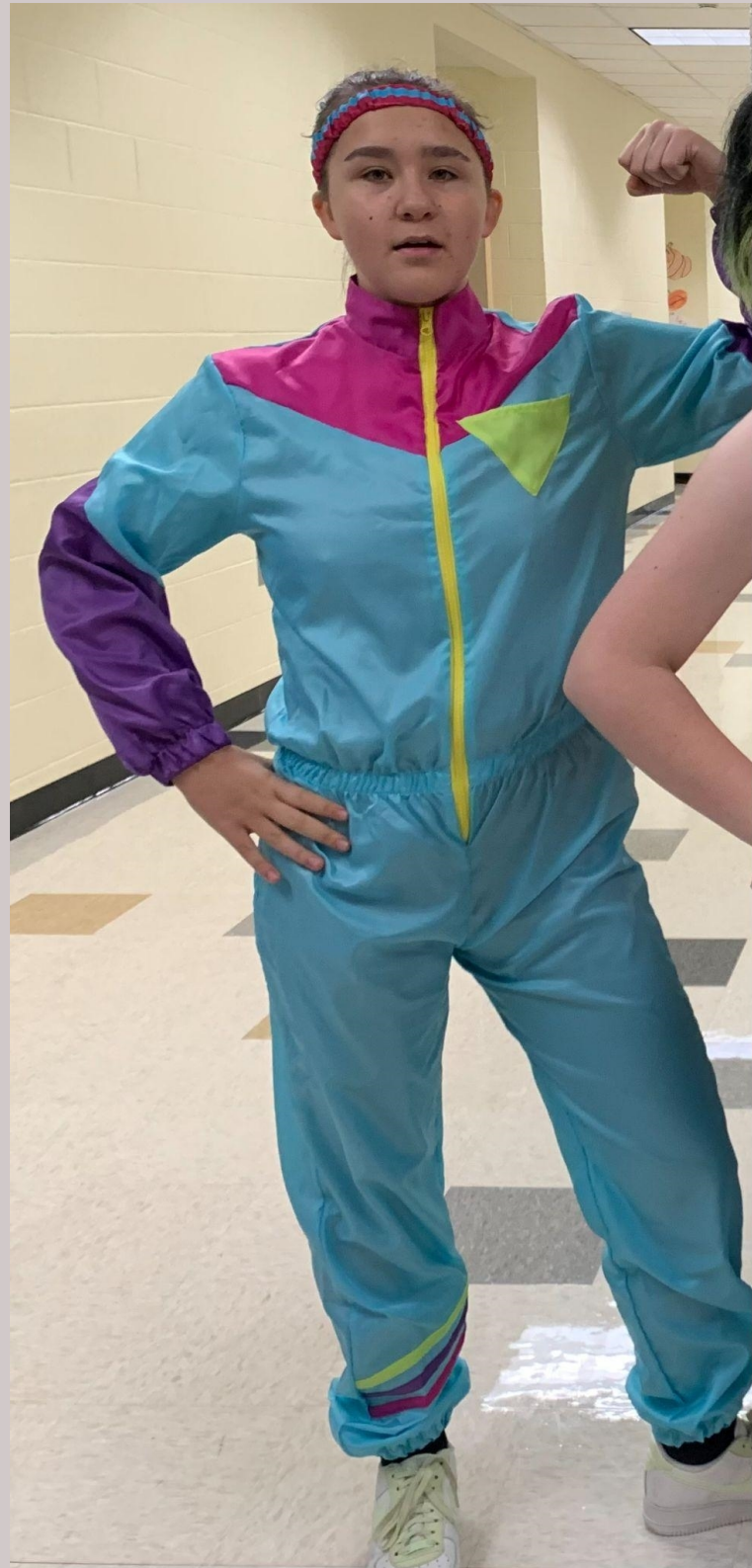

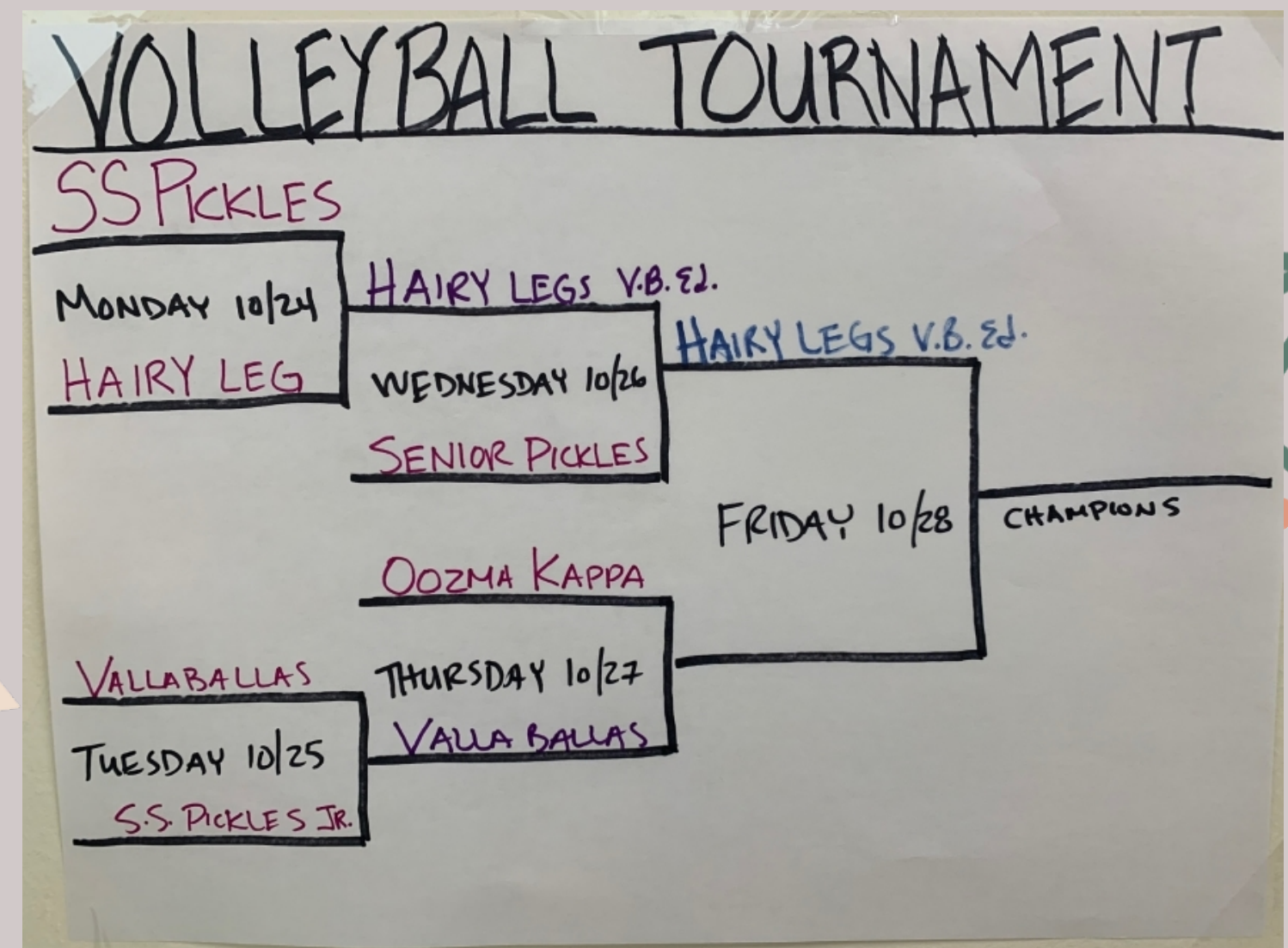

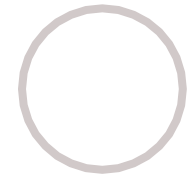

- Items range from 1-40 Sand Dollars each

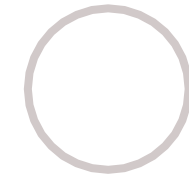

Come From Away Musical

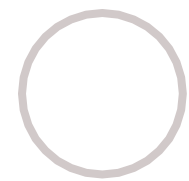

Garibaldi Boat House

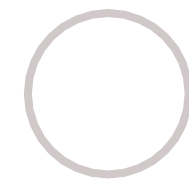

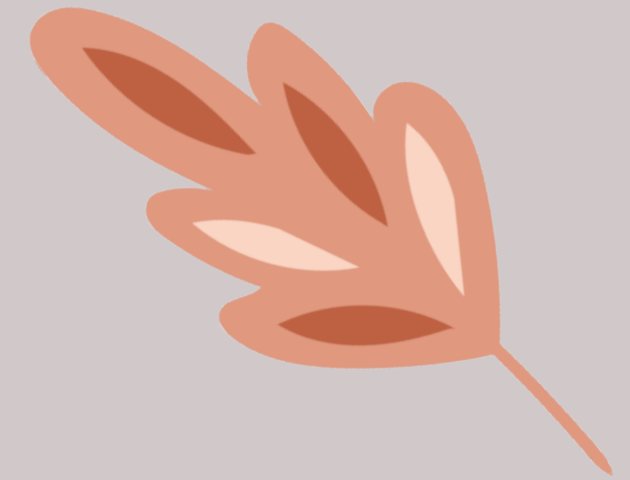

Sadie Hawkins Dance

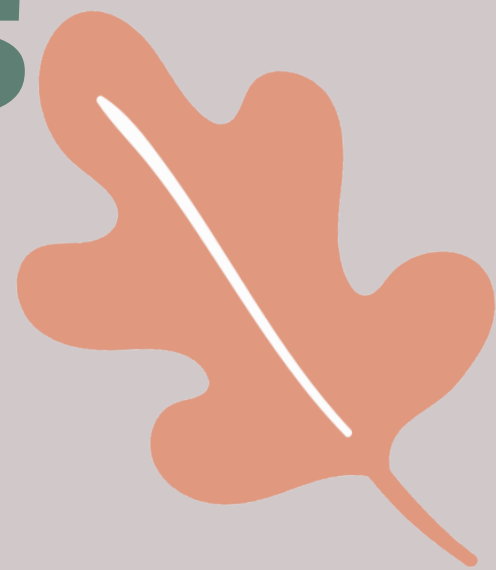
