Denton ISD's current seniors and 2008 graduates have scored well on the college readiness and preparatory tests.

PSAT scholars

Denton ISD has six seniors, who have been honored for their high scores on the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT), an assessment taken last year by high school juniors nationwide.

They were among the 1.2 million students from 20,000 high schools who entered the 2009 Merit Program. They were juniors when they took the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.

National merit semifinalists

Two seniors have been named National Merit Semifinalists. They are among an elite group of only 1,600 semifinalists throughout the United States who were named in the 2008 National Merit Scholarship Program.

Daniel Pickett - is the son of Douglas Pickett and Huguette Tran. He is in the All-Region Orchestra, the school's varsity orchestra and the diving team. He also is a member of the Guyer Physics Club and the Texas Music Teachers Association Piano Ensemble. He plans to major in bio-chemistry or pre-medicine.

Sophia Tanner - is the daughter of Harold and Sharon Tanner. She is involved in orchestra, Key Club, AP Chemistry Club, National Honor Society and Junior Classical League. She has not declared a major of study.

These national semifinalists are now eligible to compete for 8,000 Merit Scholarship Awards, which totals more than \$30 million in scholarships. Less than one percent of the students taking the PSAT qualified as a National Merit Semifinalist.

Denton ISD had three commended scholars from Guyer High and one from Ryan High. To be named a commended scholar, the students had to place in the top five percent nationwide on the PSAT test. There were less than 34,000 commended students nationwide.
