

Resolution of the Board Regarding Meeting the Requirements of the School Action Fund Redesign with Blended Learning

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2021, TEA notified Galveston ISD as the recipient of the School Action Fund for the redesign of Collegiate Academy at Weis; and

WHEREAS, TEA published guidance regarding how these funds can be used and local compliance requirements school districts must follow, including a recommendation that districts approve the design process, the design plan and the academic and operational autonomies; and

WHEREAS, Texas Education Code 11.1511 gives the Board of Trustees the exclusive power and duty to govern and oversee the management of the public schools of the District; and

WHEREAS, school redesign is predicated on the belief that students benefit when the school community, including campus leadership, have voice when implementing an innovative school model.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Galveston Independent School District approves

- The implementation of the Blended Learning Model as the Redesign Model for Collegiate Academy @ Weis which will be renamed Weis Middle School for 2022-2023
- The school redesign plan as presented during the Board Curriculum Meeting on May 4, 2022
- The Superintendent granting the academic and operational autonomies for the campus

This is effective based on the adoption date of this resolution.
