SUGGESTED SCHOOL BOARD ACTION:

Board action is required for the final reading of policies.

DESCRIPTION:

Policy revisions are due to legislative action and MSBA recommendations. If a policy is modified with minor changes that do not affect the substance of the policy or because of a legal change over which the school board has no control, the modified policy may be approved at one meeting at the discretion of the school board.

Final Reading of a Revised Policy (Board Action Required)

The following revised policies are being presented to the School Board for final reading:

- 410 – Family and Medical Leave
Brief Description: Legislative revision adding definition of “spouse”. Mandatory policy requires annual review.
- 414 – Mandated Reporting of Child Neglect or Physical or Sexual Abuse
Brief Description: Legislative revisions. Policy requires annual review.
Forms 414 – MDE and Wright County revised forms.
- 415 –Mandated Reporting of Maltreatment of Vulnerable Adults
Brief Description: Legislative revisions. Policy requires annual review.
Form 415 – Wright County revised form.
- 420 – Students and Employees with Sexually Transmitted Infections and Diseases and Certain Other Communicable Diseases and Infectious Conditions
Brief Description: Legislative revisions.
- 506 – Student Discipline
Brief Description: Legislative revisions including medical marijuana reference.
Mandatory policy requires annual review.
- 524 – Internet Responsible Use and Safety
Brief Description: No revisions – Policy requires annual review.
- 613 – Graduation Requirements
Brief Description: Legislative revisions and inclusion of MSBA language.

- 616 – School District System Accountability
Brief Description: Legislative revisions and inclusion of MSBA language.
Mandatory Policy
- 620 – Credit for Learning
Brief Description: District revision. Delete Form 620 due to deletion of Credit by Assessment language.
- 702.2 – Purchasing
Brief Description: District policy on 5-Year Review Cycle
- 806 – Crisis Management
Brief Description: Mandatory policy requires annual review.
