Subject: Weber School District TSSA Framework

Dear Members of the Board,

Over the past several months I have worked with a variety of departments to ensure alignment between our district strategic plan, Elevate28, and various processes and procedures. The attached framework includes updated language but does not adjust the way we will distribute TSSA funds to schools. We will continue to allocate 25% of the funds to go towards increases to base salary and benefits for school personnel, up to 5% of the total allocation will go towards teacher recognition and leadership opportunities, and the remaining amount will be distributed to schools based on school type and enrollment. By allocating over two-thirds of the LEA allocation directly to schools, it allows building leaders to utilize the funds to best support their unique needs and local initiatives. Schools are bound to ensure monies spent fall within the guidelines of the district framework, board rule, and legislation.
