CURRICULUM

On February 17 the K-5 principals and instructional coaches met to preview six English Language Arts curricula, one of which will be selected for as the new reading curriculum for the 25-26 school year. The previewed curricula includes; Wonders 2023, Open Court 2023, Benchmark Science of Reading Alignment, Superkids (K-2), Wit & Wisdom, and Arts & Letters. The principals and coaches will continue to review the curricula each week until three programs are selected and then those programs will be brought to the buildings for teacher review and final selection.

BPS Assessments

aimswebPLUS

The Winter Benchmark for the aimswebPLUS opens January 6 - February 7th for all students in grades K - 12 for both ELA and Math. Benchmarking assessments provide teachers with critical information about the projected expectation of students meeting grade-level standards at year end, identify next steps for instruction, as well as the ability to determine fall to winter growth for literacy and math skills.

Writing Assessment K-12

The Winter Benchmark for the 9 - 12 Writing Assessment window is January 20 - February 7, 2025 along with the Winter Benchmark for the 4 - 8 Writing Assessment; while the K - 3 Writing Assessment window is February 3 - 7, 2025.

WIDA; ACCESS 2.0

All buildings are currently testing students who are identified as English Language Learners with the ACCESS 2.0 in the schools. The window for the assessment is December 2 - February 21, 2025. Teachers who completed their certification to administer the ACCESS 2.0 are assisting Building Test Coordinators with this assessment.

Montana Aligned to Standards Through-Year

MAST

MAST is the general mathematics and reading/language arts assessment for academic state achievement reporting in Grades 3-8. The MAST assessment is aligned to the Montana Content Standards in Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA).
