The Food Service Program total meals served for the month of September 2025 are below;

The Food Service Program is in full swing with school back in session for the academic year 2025-2026. We have had an increase in student number counts this school year, primarily at BHS, BMS, and Buffalo hide Academy. And, the Supper Program has started on September 2nd and is serving Monday-Friday from 4:30pm-7:00pm at the Napi Cafeteria.

The new equipment for Napi kitchen has arrived and is now installed. The equipment includes; a warmer and salad bar server (see picture attached). The students/staff/supper program will now have warm food and cool salad bar items.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail. The copy center is now complete, and has been very busy with district copies, and getting ready for the holiday season.

The food service program does not have vacancies at this time.

The food service staff will be participating in an indigenous foods/Culinary training has been rescheduled from October 17th to November 14th which will be held at the new warehouse. The training is in collaboration with Team Nutrition, FAST Blackfeet, and Mariah Gladstone (Indikitchen). We are looking forward to incorporating Indigenous recipes into the Supper Program Menu.

The food service program will be getting ready for the upcoming holiday season and we look forward to feeding the kids and happy tummies!
