INFORMATIONAL REPORT:

The Texas Education Agency (TEA), in coordination with Region One Educational Service Center (ESC), recently conducted an Intruder Detection Audit (IDA) at one or more of the District's campuses. The IDA tests whether a campus is accessible to an unauthorized individual. The IDA seeks to help school districts identify how campuses can improve safety for students and provide the District an opportunity to create a safer learning environment for students and staff members.

Pursuant to CKC (LEGAL), "Information is confidential if the information relates to an assessment by or for a district, or an assessment that is maintained by a district, of the risk or vulnerability of persons or property, including critical infrastructure, to an act of terrorism or related criminal activity." Specific details will be discussed in the Board's executive session.
