Superintendent Report: The NIISA Conference in Las Vegas was discussed regarding training and information on vocational opportunities for students, credit recovery, tutoring. It was noted that schools have vocational options in welding, construction, automotive, journeyman, nursing, culinary and agriculture options where students graduate with certificates in those trades. Mr. Conway stated that BCC will have a virtual learning at Havre with Vo-Tech programs and suggested planning this with the BHS seniors for future. Mr. Gallup stated there were zoom meetings at the conference with NIISA and NAFIS. They will have a zoom meeting today (12/14/21) regarding a new Director and interviews in March 2022. Title Programs are okay; a group of military are pushing to pull out of Impact Aid; self-contained classrooms are using up a lot of money.
