

Strong Tier 1: Explicit phonics instruction and knowledge building



### **Rigorous Interventions**

Increase Tier 2: Additional support for struggling students



### **Strong SEL Competencies**

Build student skills in responsible decision making and self/social awareness.

# Rigorous Interventions - Why this Goal?

**Comprehensive Needs Assessment:** Identified the need for targeted instruction at Tier 2, which focuses on providing additional support for students who are struggling with reading and writing.

**Who**: Title-Intervention teachers (Ms. Radue and Mrs. Armstrong)

What: PRESS Interventions and 95 RAP Intervention

When: 30 minutes/day

Where: Classroom and small group pull-out sessions

Why: To fill phonics-skills gaps for students who tested under the 40th percentile during the fall

benchmark screener and through diagnostic assessments

#### Cycle one 16 days

Kdgn= 8 students 1st= 19 students

2nd= 10 students

3rd= 11 students

4th= 9 students

5th= 11 students

#### Cycle two 18 days

Kdgn= 8 students (7 are **new** to the group)

Ist= IG students (3 **exited** after cycle one)

2nd= G students (4 **exited** after cycle one)

Ang & Poige co-teach in two 2nd-grade classrooms

3rd= II students (I **exited** I **new** student entered)

4th= 9 students (I **exited** I **new** student entered)

5th= I2 students (I **new** student entered)



#### Cycle three 16 days

Kdgn = 8 students (Same students as cycle two)

1st= 17 students (2 exited | new student entered)


2nd= 6 students (Same students as cycle two)

3rd= 11 students (Same students as cycle two)

4th= 9 students (Same students as cycle two)

5th= 12 students (Same students as cycle two)
