Re: Curriculum Resources for Intervention Services

The district determined there was a need for Alternate Curriculum for learners with special needs including intellectual disabilities, Autism spectrum disorder (ASD), developmental delays, and social and emotional disabilities. As a result, the district issued an RFP on February 28, 2022, to select a company to provide Alternate Curriculum intended for students with moderate to severe disabilities who are not able to access the core general curriculum without significant modifications. The district received three compliant responses.

An evaluation committee comprised of representatives from both campus and central administration departments evaluated those responses to establish the best value. The resulting tabulation of those evaluations provided the following suppliers, in ranked order.

- 1. TeachTown, Jigsaw Learning LLC
- 2. Rethink Ed., Rethink Autism Inc.
- 3. N2y, LLC

District administration will attempt to negotiate a successful contract with the first ranked vendor, and if unsuccessful, we will move to the next ranked vendor.

The district administration intends to use ESSER funds to cover the cost of this service for at least the first year of the award.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approves the administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the recommended suppliers, renewed annually, not to exceed approximately \$90,000 Annually, as long as the service continues to meet the needs of the District.
