Assessments path:


- MAP Growth K-2

RIT scores: "It represents the level where a student is ready to learn, also known as the Zone of Proximal Development. The test finds that level by pinpointing where a student would just as likely answer incorrectly as correctly, the point between knowing and not knowing answers." (From NWEA)






Bloomingdale Math MAP Spring 2021
