

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED NEW RULE

DIVISION OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION RULES GOVERNING THE ARKANSAS TUTORING CORPS

These rules were created per Ark. Code Ann. §6-15-3104 to set out the responsibilities and processes of the Arkansas Tutoring Corps as well as define terms related to the program. The rules define the requirements individuals must meet to become qualified tutors and Arkansas Tutoring Corps certified members. The rules also define qualified tutoring sites.

The rules set out the responsibilities of The Arkansas Tutoring Corps. These responsibilities include identifying curriculum as well as assessing the needs to tutors across the state. Additionally, responsibilities include retaining tutors, training tutors and providing support as well as maintaining data related to the program.

The rules also list the responsibilities of Education Renewal Zones (ERZs).
