A definition of each numerical rating is presented as follows:

The Superintendent exceeded the expectations of the specific goal and results.

3 - ACCOMPLISHED

The Superintendent meets expectations & results are achieved of the specific goal.

2 - SATISFACTORY

Specific goal is met however may be lacking in important result areas.

1 - UNSATISFACTORY

The Superintendent's goal attainment and results in this category is unacceptable & requires immediate attention.

*Note: Any area determined as being performed in a less than satisfactory manner must contain recommendations on how the Superintendent can improve their performance in that area.

Areas of Goal Evaluation

- Goal 1. Tool for Equity Accountability Implementation
- Goal 2. Decrease disproportionate Out of School Suspensions for subjective reasons (according to progress targets for OSS Plan)
- Goal 3. Dissertation Completion

The overall ranking of the Superintendent as rated by the average score of all School Board members, in the evaluation areas listed above is in the "Accomplished/Satisfactory" range.
