## **Background Information**

NWEA MAP is a computer-adaptive, nationally normed assessment that measures student achievement and growth in reading, math, language usage, and science. i-Ready is a criterion-referenced assessment that measures how well students perform against grade-level standards in reading and math. The district uses both NWEA MAP and i-Ready to track student growth throughout the year. This data supports classroom instruction and is a key part of the Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA), providing objective measures of student growth to evaluate teacher effectiveness.

## Recommendation

The District recommends the renewal of the proposed agreement to NWEA MAP in the total amount of \$73,425 (locally funded), iReady diagnostic assessment for \$69,312 (locally funded), personalized instruction for \$164,977 (federally funded), Teacher Toolbox for \$71,978 (federally funded) and professional learning for \$82,800 (federally funded). It is also recommended that the Board authorize the Superintendent to finalize the contract renewal with NWEA MAP and iReady to execute the contract on behalf of the district.
