

Academic Goal for the 23-24 School Year:

By May 30, 2024, Big Sky and Glendale Schools will decrease students in ELA and mathematics Tier III by 25% and increase Tier 1 by 25% as measured by Aimsweb end of year benchmarking assessment.

Year End Results:

Big Sky and Glendale schools increased Tier III ELA students from 11 to 13 (18% increase) and Tier I remained the same at 17 students (no change).

Big Sky and Glendale Schools nearly met the mathematics goal of reducing Tier 3 by 16.6% (decreasing from 12 to 10) and increasing Tier I mathematics from 17 to 21 (increase of 23.5%).
