Recommendation:

The administration recommends rezoning the Collection at Boerne development from the Boerne Middle School North and Boerne High School attendance zones into the Voss Middle School and Champion High School attendance zones effective beginning in the 2025-2026 school year.

Summary:

In April 2024, BISD approved new elementary school attendance zones. In this rezoning, the Collection at Boerne development was zoned to Cibolo Creek Elementary. All other students from Cibolo Creek Elementary currently feed into either Boerne Middle School South, or Voss Middle School. The students residing in the Collection at Boerne Development will be the only CCES students that are currently zoned to Boerne Middle School North and Boerne High School.

For feeder pattern alignment purposes, we are recommending rezoning the Collection at Boerne development to the Voss Middle School and Champion High School attendance zones. Additionally, the most recent demographic update shows more available space at Voss Middle School than at Boerne Middle School North. So, this adjustment of the Collection at Boerne from Boerne Middle School North to Voss Middle School is beneficial for enrollment and capacity reasons as well.

Rationale:

Adjustments to our middle school and high school attendance boundaries are necessary to align campus feeder patterns and to support campus enrollments that are within our building capacities.
