

Pacific High School Cheer Club Charter

Article I: Name and Purpose

1. The name of this organization shall be the Pacific High School Cheer Club, hereinafter referred to as the "Cheer Club."
2. The purpose of the Cheer Club shall be to promote school spirit, support athletic teams, and foster camaraderie among students through the art of cheerleading.

Article II: Membership

1. Membership in the Cheer Club shall be open to all middle and high school students enrolled at Pacific High School who have an interest in cheerleading.
2. Members shall demonstrate dedication, teamwork, and respect for fellow members and coaches.
3. Members shall actively participate in club activities, practices, and performances.

Article III: Officers and Leadership

1. The Cheer Club shall have the following officer positions: Captain, Co-Captain, Secretary, and Treasurer.
2. Officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the club members at the beginning of each academic year.
3. Officers shall serve a term of one academic year, with the option of reelection.
4. The Captain shall lead practices, coordinate performances, and serve as the primary liaison between the Cheer Club and school administration.
5. The Co-Captain shall assist the Captain in their duties and assume leadership responsibilities in their absence.
6. The Secretary shall keep accurate records of club meetings, maintain membership lists, and handle club correspondence.
7. The Treasurer shall manage the club's finances, maintain financial records, and provide regular reports on the club's budget and expenses.

Article IV: Meetings

1. The Cheer Club shall hold regular meetings at least once a month during the academic year, or as determined by the officers.
2. Meetings shall be conducted in a professional manner, and all members shall have the opportunity to contribute.
3. The Captain or their designee shall create an agenda for each meeting and distribute it to club members in advance.

Article V: Activities and Performances

1. The Cheer Club shall participate in various activities and performances aimed at promoting school spirit, including cheering at athletic events, pep rallies, and community parades.
2. The Event Coordinator shall work closely with the officers and club members to plan and coordinate these activities and performances.
3. The Cheer Club shall collaborate with school sports teams, other student organizations, and the administration to enhance school spirit and support.
4. The Cheer Club will coordinate with school administration to plan fundraising activities designed to support the club and club activities.
5. As the Cheer Club is not governed by OSAA, stunts and athletic tumbling will not be practiced or performed by members at any event during which the club participates, including club meetings.

Article VI: Amendments

1. This charter may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the club members present at a regular meeting.
2. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing to the Secretary at least one week prior to the meeting at which they will be considered.
3. Amendments shall take effect immediately upon approval by the club membership.

Article VII: Ratification

1. This charter shall be ratified upon approval by a two-thirds majority vote of the club members present at a regular meeting.
2. Upon ratification, this charter shall serve as the governing document of the Pacific High School Cheer Club.

Article VIII: Dissolution

1. In the event of the dissolution of the Cheer Club, any remaining funds shall be disbursed in accordance with current district policies.
2. The officers shall be responsible for the orderly winding down of club activities and the proper disposition of club assets.
