Subject: RFP #3341-25 Virtual and Hybrid Learning for K-12

Background Information:

- This recommendation is for Request for Proposal RFP #3341-25 Virtual and Hybrid Learning for K-12. It is a new RFP for virtual and/or hybrid learning platforms and services to support the development, implementation, and ongoing support of a comprehensive virtual learning program for students in grades K-12, offering both full-time virtual education and supplemental online courses.
- This RFP was issued in conjunction with Senate Bill 569, which created a new framework (TEC Chapter 30B) for schools, allowing advanced courses online and supporting college credit.
- If awarded, this RFP will expand access to Advanced Placement, dual-credit, and career/technical education (CTE) courses online, offering flexibility and college readiness for students.
- Vendor presentations were viewed by district administration in Learning and Teaching, Special Education, the Lewisville ISD Technology Department, Virtual Learning Academy, Directors, School Chiefs, Accountability and Assessments, and the Superintendent to evaluate the products and services being proposed.
- If approved, awarding multiple vendors will help provide the District with access to a wide range of vendors, products, services, and competitive pricing in support of achieving the best value.
- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include, but are not limited to, price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors.

Administrative Consideration:

- RFP notifications were sent to 1,692 vendors, and thirteen responses were received.
- Funds for these services come from the general operating, state, and local funds.
- Estimated annual expenditures: \$3,040,000 but will not exceed the approved budget(s).
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code and applicable state, local, and federal procurement laws.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves RFP #3341-25 Virtual and Hybrid Learning for K-12, the recommended vendors, and the estimated annual expenditures for two years.
