Subject: CHHS Debate Team Trip to Harvard

### **Action Item**

#### **BOARD GOAL:**

Design and implement a rigorous instructional delivery system that is data-driven and fosters student engagement.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Cedar Hill Debate team has been attrending the Harvard Debate Tournament by invitation for approximately 10 years. Harvard is a prestigious national tournament that allows our students a unique opportunity to visit a major Ivy League campus as well as to compete against debaters from across the United States. This academic trip also encourages our students to look beyond standard college options and consider applying to Ivy League universities.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Administration recommends board approve CHHS Debate Team trip to Harvard.

## **FUNDING SOURCE:**

Airfare: student responsibility: We will probably fly Air Trans. From current prices, tickets should be approximately \$240.00 per student.

Flight Insurance: This varies with different companies. \$30.00 per person is average. I plan to use my student travel account to buy insurance in compliance with District requirements.

Ground transportation to and from the airport: Taxis to take 8 students to and from the airport cost approximately \$200.00, which is funded through student travel.

Tournament Entries: Entry fees are \$120.00 per LD Debate entry and \$75.00 per Congress entry. These will be paid from my operating budget.

Hotel: Harvard's special price at the Mariott Cambridge is \$139.00. for 4 people in a room. Hotel fees come primarily from our activity account and student payment. We will be doing one additional fund raiser to add to our activity account.

# **Harvard Trip Funding**

- See attached Air Trans listing. Currently, the least expensive round trip tickets to Boston are \$106.00 one way. Two-way tickets with taxes, etc. should be approximately \$240.00 per student. Students pay their own airfare.
- Flight insurance varies with different companies. \$30.00 per person is average, and I will plan to use my student travel budget for insurance.
- Hotel costs are funded by students and my activity budget. We will plan to add to that with one additional fund raiser this year. Sponsor hotel room is taken from travel budget.
- We will plan to stay at the Marriott Cambridge because that is the official "tournament hotel." Student Congress rounds will be held at the Marriott on Saturday, and I will have at least one Congress competitor. This year's room price for 4 people at the Marriott is \$139.00. The Marriott is also very convenient to a subway station and is only 2 stops away from the Harvard campus. We primarily use public transportation in Boston which students pay for.
