Purpose: Update on School Reopening Workgroup

Background:

The School Reopening Workgroup began their work together on Thursday, June 11th. With strong interest from our community and staff, it is crucial that we provide regular highlights and materials from the work of this group on the progress throughout the summer. Additionally, I have established a Staff Reopening Workgroup that is open to any employee of Shorewood School District which provides more opportunity for teacher and staff feedback, as well as collaboration between the two groups. The Staff Reopening Workgroup had their first meeting on June 16th.

School Reopening Workgroup

The first two meetings have been informative and productive and we are encouraged by the progress to present a deliverable report to the School Board at the August 11th meeting.
