Lincoln, Adam Metzger - Stated enrollment is steady. The parents seem to be very supportive and flexible. Attendance is up 2%. He thanked the School Board for their support and dedication.

Jr High, Lisa Mayhall - Stated chronic absenteeism went down which leads to scores going up. She delivered an appreciation poster to the School Board signed by the students.

High School, Kevin McDonald – Stated Graduation rate fell from 86.5% to 83.3%. There has been a 5% loss of students to home-schooling. The blood Drive held was successful and helps provide scholarships. The Sister School in Germany is sending 10-12 students to Pana this year and they expect to be able to send some of our students to Germany next year.

Curriculum and Instruction

Director of Curriculum and Instruction, Paul Donahue, gave his report on curriculum and instruction. All schools were commendable. The High School increased by 5 points, which is unusual at that level.

Buildings and Transportation

Jeff Stauder was in attendance and gave his report. He hired a new bus driver, but still is in need of 2 more.
