Unity School District - Board of Education Board Policy 371 Clubs/Student Organizations Last Revised 10/8/2019

The Unity School District recognizes the responsibility of the school to help prepare young people for their role as responsible citizens.

As one means of meeting this responsibility, the Unity School Board encourages the involvement of students in political activities. The following guidelines are adopted by the Unity Board of Education so that these activities may be available in the school.

- 1. Student clubs may be organized within the schools on the same basis as other organizations or clubs:
 - A. All authorized school clubs or organizations must have a faculty advisor who is approved by the principal.
 - B. All authorized school clubs or organizations must have their constitution filed with and approved by the student council principal. The constitution shall be shared with the student council.
 - C. All fund accounting and fundraising must be approved and scheduled by the high school principal.
