Job Summary for Special Education Teacher:

Special Education Teacher will provide push-in specialized instruction to students who require Extended School Year (ESY) services. Work will be to address goals outlined on the ESY plan of their IEP. Will work with ESY Coordinator, teaching teams and therapists for the successful implementation of ESY.

Duties and Responsibilities for Special Education Teacher:

- Plan and maintain a program of instruction that is conducive to the attainment of individual students' ESY goals and objectives on their IEP.
- Apply appropriate strategies to educate students with special needs, in compliance with State and Federal regulations.
- Develop and nurture the emotional, cognitive and social abilities of the students. *Interact with students in a polite, caring and respectful manner.
- Respond to student misbehavior appropriately and successfully.
- Demonstrate clear and accurate oral and written communication.
- Engage students in learning
- Monitor student progress toward achievement of instructional goals and write end of ESY progress reports.
- Maintains high standards of ethical behavior and confidentiality of student information.
- Demonstrates regular and predictable attendance.
- Work cooperatively with staff, students and parents
- Communicates with appropriate stakeholders, including families, home districts, etc regarding student's performance in ESY
