

LINZ INVITATIONAL CHORAL FESTIVAL Linz, Austria

The Odessa High School Choral Program has been invited to attend the Linz Choral Festival held in Linz Austria.

When:

Depart on June 7 or 8, 2007 by bus to make a plane departure from Dallas International Airport on the morning of June 8 or 9, 2007. We will return to Dallas on June 18 or 19, 2007 and attent to Dallas on June 18 or 19,

2007 and return by bus to Odessa.

Where:

The students will visit:

Prague, Czechoslovakia – Jewel of the former iron curtain, considered the capitol of Western Europe and briefly the seat of the Holy Roman Empire.

Salzburg, Austria – The "Heart of the heart of Europe, Home of Amadeus Mozart and the site of "Sound of Music."

Linz, Austria – the Home of Anton Bruckner

Cesky Krumlov, Czechoslovakia – A medieval town showing Europe as it looked 500 years ago, a major historical city and major educational treasure.

Vienna, Austria – Seat of the ruling Hapsburg family of Europe, major opera house and site of many economic and peace summit conferences.

What:

The students will sing with the Budevice Symphony Orchestra (a professional Czech orchestra) and several other American high school choirs under the direction of Dr. Ken Fulton of Louisiana State University, at the Terezin War Memorial in Prague and a possible performance where the von Trapps were married in Mondsee, Austria

Cost:

Trip - \$2775.00, an additional fee for participation in the festival - \$150.00 to \$250.00 (depending on the total festival student participation) and part of cost of bus transportation to and from Dallas.
