

Project Synopsis:

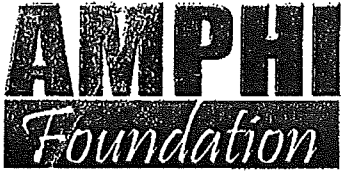
This project is an opportunity to incorporate math, art, and social studies into both an experience and an evolving piece of artwork.

Sustainability: Moving forward, it would be ideal that this become a tradition. Students could be a part of this project at a designated grade level. Staff members would make a new tile each school year.

- Monetary costs would include the purchase of additional clay, glaze, and tile adhesive.
- The tiles may need maintenance over time; some may need to be re-adhered to the surface.
- If the project is to become a tradition, the Painted Sky Elementary Principal would need to approve/designate alternative wall space for tiles to be displayed.


