Background Information:

Keller High School

The original Keller High School building is currently not served by a fire suppression system. The City of Keller has allowed the district to continue to operate without a fire suppression system, with the understanding that one would be installed. This project is being developed as a Construction Manager at Risk delivery.

- The Learning Center
 - As a condition of being issued a building permit, the District agreed to provide screening of roof-top equipment, an onsite parking lot, and landscaping. This project is being developed as a competitive sealed proposal delivery.
- New Middle School Approved in the 2005 Bond Program for completion by August 2006.
- New Intermediate School Approved in the 2005 Bond Program for completion by August 2006.
- Two New Elementary Schools Approved in the 2005 Bond Program for completion by August 2006.

Administrative Considerations:

It is necessary to select architectural firms to prepare contract documents for the work.

Keller High School and The Learning Center

 After reviewing AIA qualifications from seven architectural firms, we along with the Facilities sub-committee conducted interviews with several firms. We are requesting that VLK Architects be named as the architectural firm for the Keller High School project and Halbach-Dietz Architects be named as the architectural firm for The Learning Center project at a fee of 7% per project.

Intermediate, Middle, and Elementary schools

- The Facilities Committee recommended using existing prototypes for these projects based on staff satisfaction of function and the advantages of saving time and fees. We are requesting VLK Architects be named as the architectural firm for the new middle school and the two elementary schools with a fee of 4%. We request that Hahnfeld Hoffer Stanford be named as the architectural firm for the new intermediate school with a fee of 4%.
- Copies of the contracts will be available at the meeting.

The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the architect selections for new construction and renovation projects as presented.
